## Disciplinary Code • Season 2009-2010

*The Crouch End Vampires Disciplinary Code is an in-house system designed to ensure that our club and its members maintain the high standards of fair play and behaviour expected in SAL and AFA football.*

### Principles of behaviour

1. A “No Pay, No Play” policy is operated by the club. All monies owed by players must be paid in full before season starts.
2. Dissent and violent behaviour will not be tolerated by any members.
3. All captains must ensure that all cautions, dismissals and any other incidents of misconduct are reported to one of the following club officers on the day and put on the match report sheet. Failure to report incidents may result in any disciplinary points given being doubled.

4. All players will serve any suspension and pay any fine imposed by SAL or AFA and any Club fine or suspension.

### Disciplinary Points

5. **Cautions C1, i.e. tackling:** The player will incur a 1 point penalty. If that player receives no further points for 4 weeks the point incurred will become inactive and (s)he can continue playing with no punishment. However, if the player is cautioned within the 4 week period, the player will be suspended accordingly.
6. A player cautioned for **dissent** will receive 2 disciplinary points which will remain live on the player’s record for the rest of the season.
7. **All Red cards:** The player will be automatically suspended until he comes in front of the Discipline Committee and one team captain other than his own, and the Committee will decide what punishment – if any – will be administered.

### Suspensions

2 points	=	2 week suspension
3 points	=	5 week suspension
4 points	=	suspended until appearance before Discipline Committee
Over 5 pts	=	suspended for the rest of the season.
